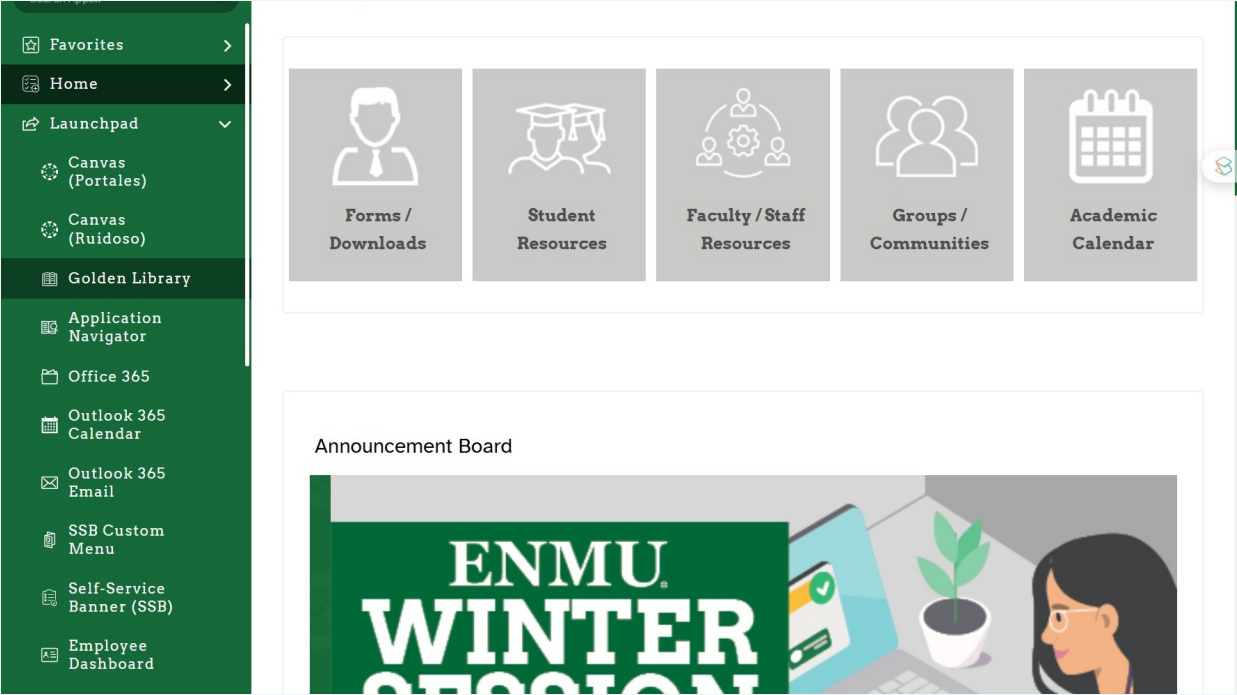
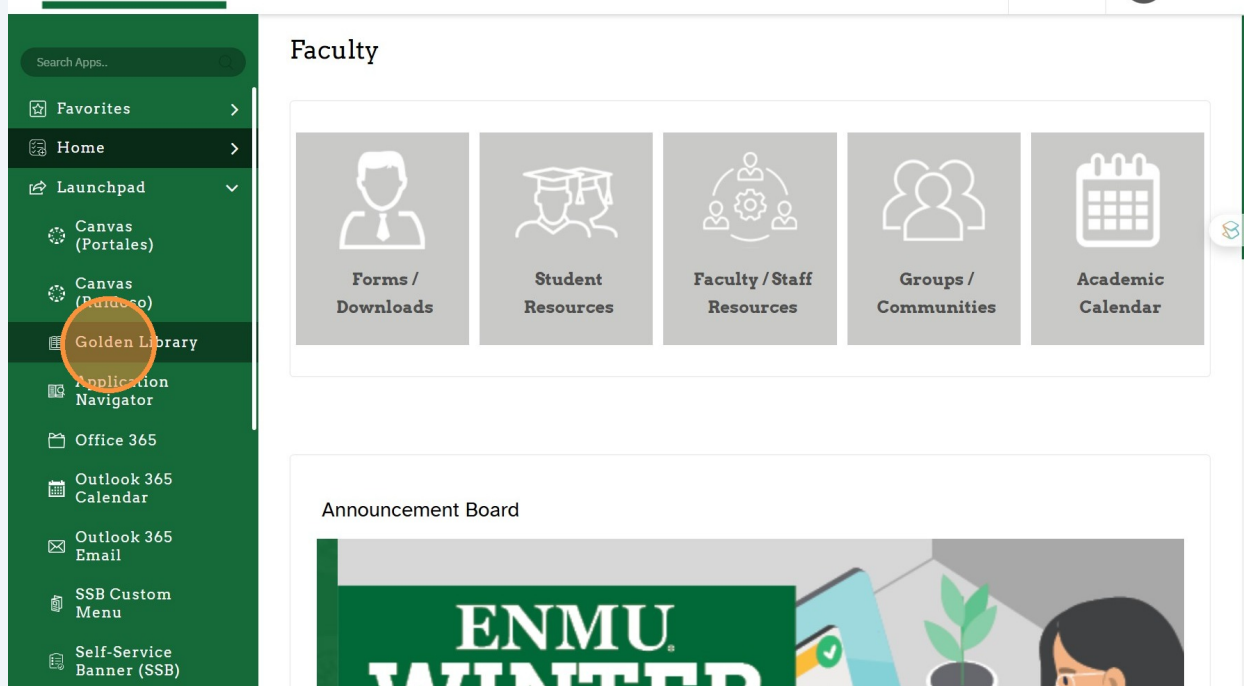


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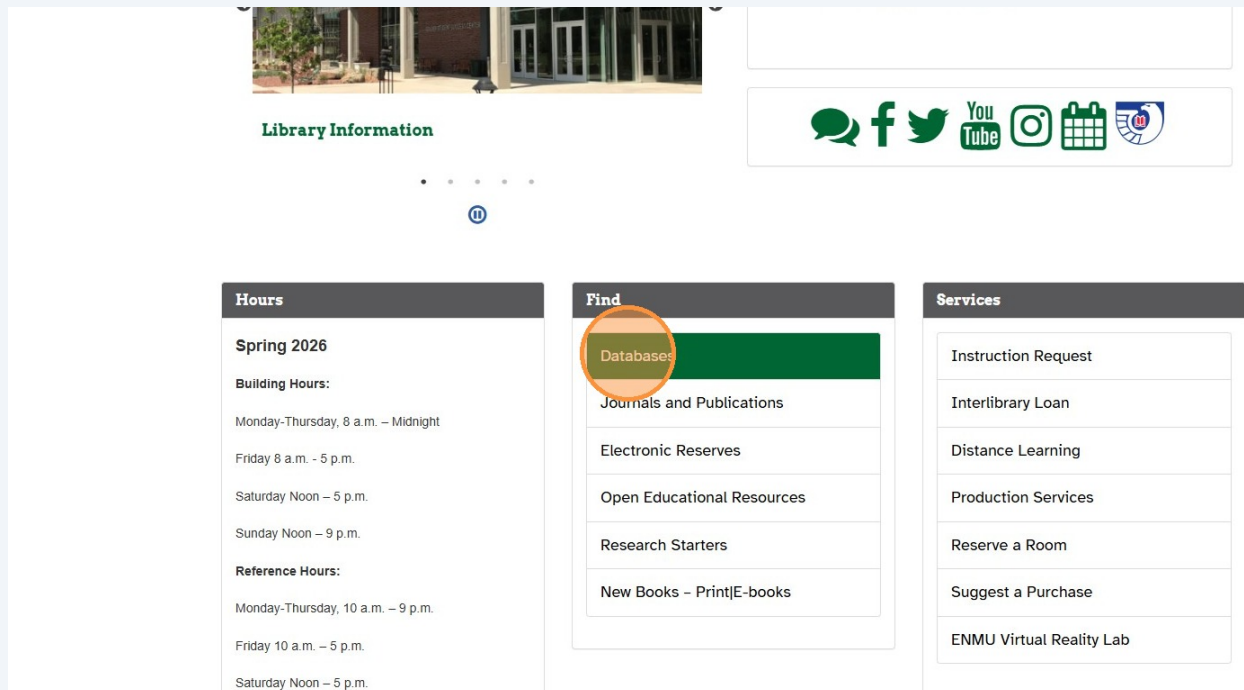

Psychology Collection

Psychology Collection provides access to academic journals and magazines that cover the study of emotions, personality, and the human mind. The database offers content of interest to both researchers and general users.

Psychotherapy.net offers a library of over 300 training videos featuring the leading psychotherapy practitioners. This is a trial subscription.

PsycINFO

The PsycINFO® database, American Psychological Association's (APA) renowned resource for abstracts of scholarly journal articles, book chapters, books, and dissertations, is the largest resource devoted to peer-reviewed literature in behavioral science and mental health. It contains records and summaries dating as far back as the 1600s with one of the highest DOI matching rates in the publishing industry. Journal coverage, which spans from the 1800s to the present, includes international material selected from periodicals in dozens of languages.

PubAg

PubAg is the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), National Agricultural Library's (NAL) search system for agricultural information. It is available for free on the internet. PubAg contains full-text articles relevant to the agricultural sciences, along with citations to peer-reviewed journal articles with links to publisher sites and elsewhere for full-text access and covers all of the core topics of the agricultural sciences including nutrition, food safety, food quality, animal and crop production and protection, natural resources, sustainable agricultural systems, rural development, agricultural economic and policy issues, agricultural imports and exports, agricultural statistics, extramural research, and Extension education.

Kanopy

Kanopy is a streaming video resource with a collection of over 26,000 films on ever imaginable and from leading producers Criterion Collection, The Great Courses Films, HBO California Newsreel, and more. The website makes it easy to watch, share, and download films across campus. Enjoy!

New Mexico Reads

This ebook and audiobook collection from the New Mexico State Library includes history and culture titles and fiction by authors or set in the Southwest. 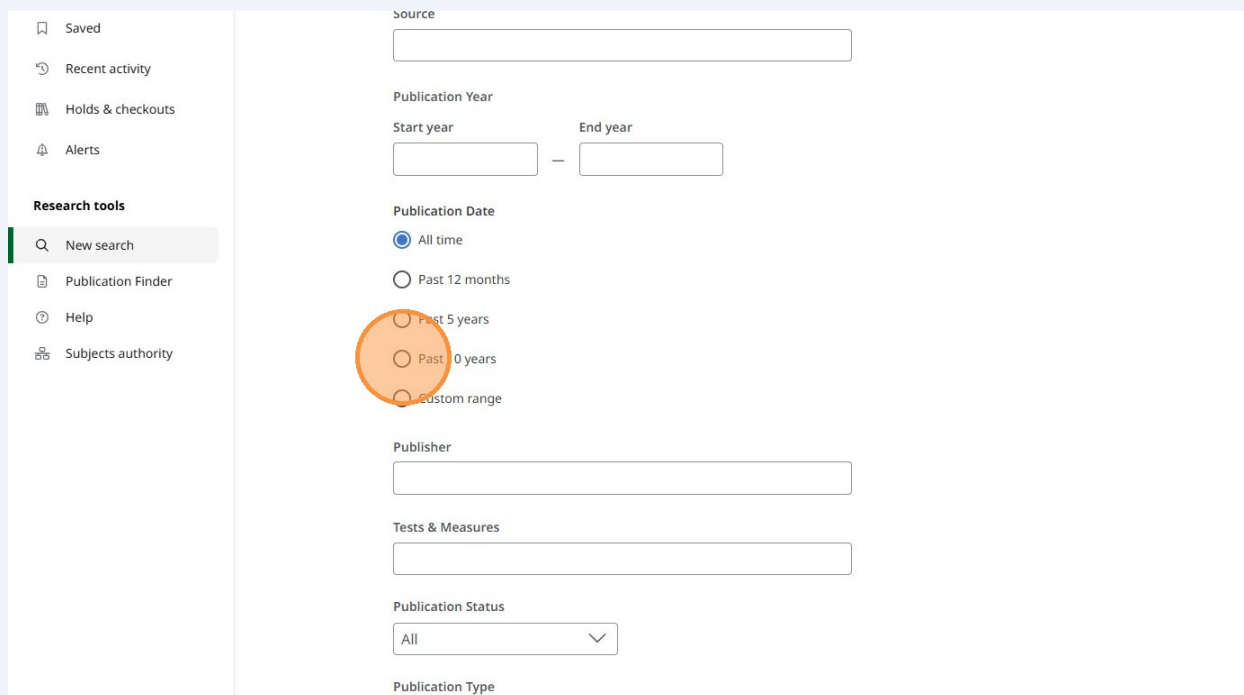

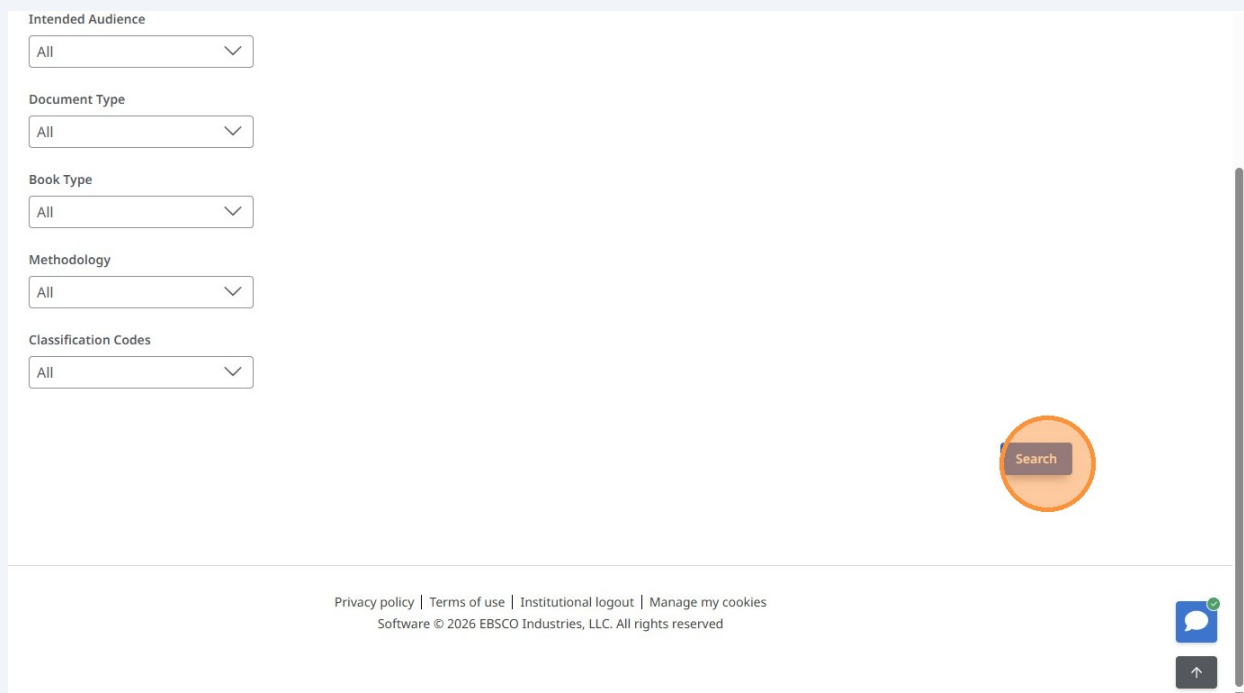
